**Project overview:** At present there are nearly 132 million people in Bangladesh out of which 1/3 is youth. Youth have a significant role to play in setting the tone for the future of the country. Highlighting the misery of youth needs to be done very cautiously, for it would be unfair to give the impression that the overall economy is suffering, for that is not the case. Thus, the overall situation of youth in Bangladesh is actually quite an alarming one for economic misery is leading to social and emotional catastrophe as well and an unfortunate degree of stress. The involvement of some young people- in violence and extremist groups but while the majority of youth are not violent and do not participate in violence. Moreover, a growing body of evidence suggests that young women and men can and do play active and valuable roles as agents of positive and constructive change.
